



# 29 Ball Color Set

**"The unique multiple games set..."**



### THREE PLAYER COLOR EIGHT BALL

Three players can play Eight Ball at the same time. Three color groups of five balls each and a black ball are racked at random in a sixteen ball diamond rack with the black ball in the center front position. The front ball is placed on the foot spot. The official Rules for Two Player Eight-Ball as set forth by the Billiard Congress of America can be followed if desired. The only rule that would change is that a player cannot lose a game by a foul of pocketing the black ball. If the black ball is illegally pocketed, it is spotted on the foot spot and next player has ball in hand. For more leisurely play, the following rules can be used:

- (1) Order of shooting and color group selection is made before play begins.
- (2) Players take turns breaking
- (3) Player must hit his ball first in attempting to pocket a ball
- (4) If an opponent's ball is pocketed and the player has not legally pocketed a ball from his group, the player's inning ends
- (5) If a player fails to hit one of his group of balls first, the next player has ball in hand
- (6) Player must call the pocket for the black ball when it is legal play. Breakers ball color group is placed on the front and rear corners of the rack and the other player's colors are placed on the side corners of the rack.



### FOUR PLAYER COLOR EIGHT BALL

Eight ball for four players who would prefer to play as individuals rather than as partners. Four color groups of four balls each are racked at random in a sixteen ball diamond rack with different color on each corner. The black ball is placed on the head spot before play begins. Follow the rules as stated for Three Player Eight Ball.

### FOUR PLAYER COLOR CUTTHROAT

**"The Most Enjoyable Game for Social Play"**

Four color groups of four balls each racked at random in a sixteen ball diamond rack with a different color on each corner. Order of shooting and color group selection is made before play begins. A player wins having a ball or balls on the table after all other players' balls are pocketed. Players can play any combination, bank, carom, or even hit his ball first in an attempt to pocket an opponent's ball. A player may even pocket his own ball to continue shooting. If a player should happen to pocket his last ball before clearing the table, he is out and the remaining players continue to play. If a player scratches, the other players can return one of their pocketed balls to the table. To prevent excess stacking, the balls are spotted first on the foot spot, next on the head spot, and then the center spot. If all the spots are occupied, stacking begins behind the foot spot. If the incoming player has a ball to spot, it is placed on the center spot.



### 2-Ball Wipeout (Color Cribbage)



### TWO BALL COLOR WIPEOUT

Two or more players. Intermediate skills. A game similar to cribbage but much easier to follow. Game is based on color pairs. A point is scored when both balls of a single color are pocketed one after another. Game can be used for tournament play because the rules are designed so that the game can continue from rack to rack. After pocketing seven pairs, the pocketed balls are racked with the front and rear corners empty. If any balls of the remaining pair are in the rack space they are first spotted on the head spot and then the center spot. If the cue ball is in the rack space, the current player has ball in hand. Any winning score can be predetermined before play begins.

**Existing games of three player and five player cutthroat that can be played with this set.**



### THREE PLAYER CUTTHROAT

Three color groups of five balls each are racked in a fifteen ball rack. The balls are racked at random with a different color on each corner. Follow the rules that are given for Four Player Cutthroat.



### FIVE PLAYER CUTTHROAT

Five color groups of three balls each are racked in a fifteen ball rack. The balls are racked at random with a different color on each corner. Follow the rules that are given for Four Player Color Cutthroat. By adding a black ball and using a sixteen ball diamond rack. Five Player Color Eight Ball can also be played with this set of balls.
