

GENERAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Slate Bed Pool Tables

Never attempt to move or adjust the location of your table as it may adversely affect the levelness of your playfield.

Avoid sitting or standing on the table. Use a bridge for difficult to reach shots.

Avoid placing hot or cold containers on the rails or on the playfield. As with any fine furniture finish, this could leave marks on the finish.

Brush and vacuum the cloth when necessary.

Apply polish to the finish (of wood tables) for continued beauty and protection.

“COMMON SENSE PRECAUTIONS”

All participants and bystanders in the immediate area of this table should be made aware of the following safety precautions:

1. Fingers should not be placed on the edge of the rail cushions while game is in progress. High velocity impacts on fingers can be very painful and may result in bruised or broken fingers.
2. Due to the inherent nature of this game, a ball will occasionally be deflected off the playing surface following a hard shot or “miss-cue.” Players and bystanders should be alerted to this potential and take the necessary precautions.
3. If children are permitted to use the table, they should be given instruction on the safe and proper method to play the game so as to avoid injury resulting from accidentally hitting a bystander with a cue stick.
4. Care should be taken to avoid injury resulting from accidentally hitting a bystander with a cue stick.
5. Avoid placing seats for spectators too near the table.
6. Prevent small children from approaching the table while game is in progress.
